
ARTICLE V DIVISION 2 - DEPARTMENTS FOR CHANGES IN THE 2019 BUDGET

The Racine County Board of Supervisors does ordain as follows:

 To the Honorable Members of the Racine County Board of Supervisors:

Part 1

Section 2-256 of the Racine County Code of Ordinances relating to the organizational chart is hereby amended to read as follows:

Part 2

is hereby amended to read as follows: Sec. 2-266. - Created.

The following departments are created for Racine County and shall be under the direction and supervision of their respective department heads who shall be under the direction and supervision of the county executive:

(1) The finance department which shall include the office of auditor, the purchasing division and the printing and services division.

Section 2-266 of the Racine County Code of Ordinances relating to departments

(2) The human resources department.

(3) The information technology department.

(4) The corporation counsel's office which shall include the office of Child Support Enforcement.

 (5) The public works and development services department which shall include the parks division, the building and facilities division, the highway division, the Reefpoint Marina the development services division, the land conservation division and the land information division.

(6) The human services department which shall include a youth and family division, an adult services division, an economic support division, an operations division, workforce development division, a fiscal division, a veteran's service office, health service, jail alternatives, and office of medical examiner.

(7) The communications department.

Part 3

 Section 2-274 of the Racine County Code of Ordinances relating to Information Systems is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 2-274. – Information Technology.

There shall be an information technology department. The duties of the information technology department shall be to provide technical support and assistance to all departments in the county in the areas of electronic communications technology. This includes connections to external communications sources, central business systems, internal/wide area network infrastructure, desktop systems/peripherals, voice, video and data systems. The information technology director shall be in charge of the information technology department and shall be appointed by the county executive and confirmed by the board of supervisors.

Section 2-276 of the Racine County Code of Ordinances relating to Human Services is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 2-276. - Human services.

There shall be a human services department which shall have the powers, duties and functions as set forth in this section and W.S.A., ch. 46. The human services department shall provide social services to people in the areas of mental illness treatment; developmental disabilities services; income maintenance; alcohol and drug abuse services; services to children, youth and delinquents, including the operation of a secured detention facility; and long-term support services to the elderly, and physically disabled population. To carry out the duties and responsibilities of W.S.A., ch. 46, the human services department is composed of seven (7) divisions: youth and family; adult services; economic support; operations; fiscal; workforce development and health services. In addition, the human services department shall, as authorized by the board of supervisors, administer federal and state funded employment and training programs and public welfare programs and operate the workforce development center. The human services director shall be in charge of the human services department and shall be appointed by the county executive and confirmed by the board of supervisors.. The human services department shall include the veterans service office which shall report to the workforce development division manager. The powers and duties of the veteran's services officer shall include those set forth in W.S.A., ch. 45, and this Code. Pursuant to W.S.A., ch.45, the veteran's services officer shall be appointed by the county executive and confirmed by the board of supervisors. The human services department shall include the office of medical examiner. The human services department shall include health services. The purpose of health services is to provide mental health and AODA treatment to those in need of such services and is an outpatient clinic licensed by the State of Wisconsin to participate in Medicare, Medicaid, private insurance programs, and shall include jail alternatives.

Sec. 2-441. - Privacy policy for electronic records.

- 13 The purpose of this section is to ensure sufficient protections for the privacy of (a) 14 personal information as the county implements citizen-centered e-government. The county board of supervisors shall decide what personal information is made 16 available to the public on the internet.
 - The information technology director, before developing or procuring information (b) technology that disseminates personal identifying information to the public on the internet, shall:
- 20 (1) Conduct a privacy impact assessment;
 - Ensure review of the assessment by the corporation counsel and the relevant (2) department head(s);
 - Report the assessment to the intergovernmental relations committee of the Racine county board of supervisors. It shall refer the assessment to the board of supervisors with its recommendation thereon; and
 - (4) Receive county board approval through the county board of supervisors adopting a resolution stating such.
- 28 Personal identifying information means any of the following information:
- 29 (1) An individual's name;
 - (2) An individual's address;
 - (3) An individual's telephone number;
- 32 (4) An individual's driver license number;
- 33 (5) An individual's Social Security number;
- 34 An individual's employer or place of employment; (6)
- 35 (7) The maiden name of the individual's mother:
- 36 (8) An individual's biometric identification.
