Authorization to Purchase a Vehicle for Health Services Using Existing Grant

Revenue

We are looking to purchase a vehicle with a safety cage installed for use in our Crisis division. Our staff, in any of the Crisis units, are tasked with providing transportation to individuals who may be experiencing an acute crisis. Some of these individual's behaviors/symptoms are unpredictable and may pose a safety concern to our staff. There are not always two staff available to assist in transporting difficult or unknown consumers. Having a vehicle with a safety cage would allow staff to transport these consumers safely, without having to ask assistance from other staff or potentially other community partners.

We are requesting authorization to purchase this asset in Health Services, using existing grant revenue from a State grant (Specialized Transportation), which will otherwise go unspent. The State has approved the purchase as an allowable expense. In order to use these state funds, we need to take delivery of the vehicle in this calendar year. Therefore, we are requesting a 1st and 2nd reading at the November 12th County Board meeting.
