**RESOLUTION BY THE FINANCE AND HUMAN RESOURCES COMMITTEE  
AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF \$7,500.00 FROM THE CONTINGENT ACCOUNT  
TO THE CULTURAL 2019 BUDGET TO FUND THE DONATION OF \$7,500.00 TO STOP  
CHILD ABUSE AND NEGLECT (SCAN) PROGRAMMING**

To the Honorable Members of the Racine County Board of Supervisors:

**WHEREAS**, the Stop Child Abuse & Neglect (SCAN) program teaches child abuse prevention in all Racine Unified School District elementary and middle schools, most Racine private and parochial schools, many schools in western Racine County, and Kenosha Unified Elementary Schools; and

**WHEREAS**, SCAN lessons teach kids to recognize abuse, report it if it occurs, and identify sources of support; above all, they learn that abuse is never a child’s fault; and

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that the transfers set forth in Exhibit “A” that is attached hereto and incorporated herein from the Contingent Account to the Cultural 2019 Budget are authorized and approved.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that the donation of \$7,500.00 to Stop Child Abuse and Neglect (SCAN), a program of Focus on Community, in furtherance of the County’s commitment under Wis. Stat. § 59.53(21) to prevent child abuse and provide child abuse education, relief, and services is authorized and approved.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that any two of the County Clerk, the County Executive and/or the County Board Chairman are authorized to execute any contracts, agreements or other documents necessary to carry out the intent of this resolution.

**WHEREAS**, for decades, SCAN programs have been free of charge to partner schools; however, shifting trends have nonprofits searching for diversification in funding streams to secure sustainability and SCAN is no exception; and

**WHEREAS**, in the 2018-2019 school year, SCAN is in the unfortunate position of operating with a \$15,000 deficit; and

**WHEREAS**, SCAN has secured \$7,500 in funding toward that deficit, and, with Racine County's \$7,500 match, will be in a position to fulfill its programming for the 2018-2019 school year as it approaches school districts to start a dialog about partial school support of costs to promote sustainability.
