This device is a critical tool utilized by law enforcement to extract and decode data from digital devices. Data that can prove invaluable in criminal investigations.

The Sheriff's Office respectfully requests a resolution for the expenditure of \$11,500 on Cellebrite Extraction equipment and accept revenue of \$11,500 from the Dept of Justice.

In order to receive reimbursement through DOJ the equipment must be purchased, and receipts submitted by the end of February 2019. Therefore, we are requesting the resolution to be placed before the board for 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> reading as soon as possible.

As discussed in our telephone call the week of January 28, 2019, the Wisconsin Department of Justice will reimburse the Racine County Sheriff's Office for one Cellebrite device (approximately \$11,500) as part of your agency's Internet Crimes Against Children program.
