

ORDINANCE NO. 2018-149

ORDINANCE BY THE PUBLIC WORKS, PARKS AND FACILITIES COMMITTEE
AMENDING SECTION 14 OF THE RACINE COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES
RELATING TO RACINE COUNTY PARKS

To the Honorable Members of the Racine County Board of Supervisors:

The Racine County Board of Supervisors do ordain as follows:

Chapter 14, Article III, Division 1, Section 14 of the Racine County Code of Ordinances relating to Racine County Parks is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 14-64. - Hours entry permitted.

A person shall enter or be upon county park property only between the hours as posted in each park with the exception of temporary beer gardens, as previously approved, which are subject to extended hours.

Sec. 14.70. – Possession, consumption of alcoholic beverages.

- (a) Except as provided in (b), (c) and (d), no person shall bring into, possess or consume any spirit, wine, fermented malt beverage or liquor in any park, recreation area or parkway.
- (b) The public works committee is hereby authorized to designate areas where only fermented malt beverages shall be allowed upon the written permission of the committee, including but not limited to for purposes of temporary beer gardens as authorized by both the public works committee and the Racine County Board pursuant to the established application procedure.
- (c) The prohibition in (a) does not apply to areas where such beverages are sold by licensees of the county.
- (d) Wine, spirits, liquor and fermented malt beverages shall be allowed in designated areas of the Racine Harbor Park upon written permission of the public works committee or approved beer garden application.

Sec. 14-73. - Control of dogs.

No person shall suffer or permit his dog to be in or upon any county park or recreational area at any time except for Sanders Park, Cliffside Park, Harbor Park and the Karen A. Nelson Dog Park at Quarry Lake Park, or any beer gardens where dogs

4 shall be permitted in designated areas only and on the bicycle trails but as permitted in
5 this section. All posted rules pertaining to handlers' responsibilities shall be strictly
6 enforced. Dogs shall be allowed on the Racine County bicycle trails, but no person
7 shall suffer or permit his dog to be on said trails unless:

9 (1) Said dog is on a leash of suitable strength not more than six (6) feet in
10 length.

11 (2) Said person must have on his or her possession means or items capable of
12 removing deposits of fecal material.

13

14 (3) That if a dog deposits any fecal material, said person must pick up, properly
15 wrap and remove said fecal material to an appropriate container.

16

17 (4) All dogs must be properly licensed.

27 No glass beverage containers shall be permitted in any county park, with the exception
28 of within temporary beer gardens, as authorized in the beer garden application by this
29 Committee.
