WHEREAS, Racine County has been awarded a grant in the amount of \$123,325.00, by the State of Wisconsin Department of Justice, under the Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) program, to help Racine County pay the costs for the Second Judicial Veterans Treatment Court (SJDVTC); and, it diverts eligible veteran defendants with substance dependency and/or mental illness charged with felony or misdemeanor non-violent criminal offenses, to a specialized court docket; and

WHEREAS, the SJDVTC has been established to provide judicial support, treatment and supervision, thereby enhancing public safety and honoring veterans by restoring them to a productive life; and

WHEREAS, the goals of the SJDVTC are to improve access to veterans' services, identify the veteran and expedite the court system process, facilitate sobriety, improve health and reduce criminal recidivism, and consolidates the resources from Kenosha, Racine and Walworth counties: and

WHEREAS, acceptance of this implementation grant would fund continuation of the successful Veterans Treatment Court established on November 14, 2012; and

WHEREAS, acceptance of this grant is in the best interest of Racine County and fully consistent with public safety and with the needs and concerns of its citizens, especially veterans with substance dependency and/or mental illness; and

WHEREAS, there is a \$30,831.00 local match provided by the State of Wisconsin for Probation Officer and Treatment Court Coordinator.
