28 **WHEREAS**, Racine County has been awarded a grant in the amount of \$123,325.00, by
29 the State of Wisconsin Department of Justice, under the Justice Assistance Grant (JAG)
30 program, to help Racine County pay the costs for the Second Judicial Veterans Treatment Court
31 (SJDVTC); and, it diverts eligible veteran defendants with substance dependency and/or mental
32 illness charged with felony or misdemeanor non-violent criminal offenses, to a specialized court
33 docket; and

35 **WHEREAS**, the SJDVTC has been established to provide judicial support, treatment
36 and supervision, thereby enhancing public safety and honoring veterans by restoring them to a
37 productive life; and

39 **WHEREAS**, the goals of the SJDVTC are to improve access to veterans' services,
40 identify the veteran and expedite the court system process, facilitate sobriety, improve health
41 and reduce criminal recidivism, and consolidates the resources from Kenosha, Racine and
42 Walworth counties; and

44 **WHEREAS**, acceptance of this implementation grant would fund continuation of the
45 successful Veterans Treatment Court established on November 14, 2012; and

47 **WHEREAS**, acceptance of this grant is in the best interest of Racine County and fully
48 consistent with public safety and with the needs and concerns of its citizens, especially veterans
49 with substance dependency and/or mental illness; and

51 **WHEREAS**, there is a \$30,831.00 local match provided by the State of Wisconsin for
52 Probation Officer and Treatment Court Coordinator.
