WHEREAS, the construction of the Kenosha Casino will result in thousands of permanent and constructions jobs for Racine County and all of Wisconsin; and

WHEREAS, the United States Bureau of Indian Affairs has stated that the final decision can be an affirmative one until the date February 19, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the Menominee Nation has given assurances that it will indemnify the State of Wisconsin if any expenditures are required to be paid to the Potawatomi Nation.

 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors reaffirms its position and urges Governor Walker to approve the Kenosha Casino as an historic and significant economic development for Kenosha County, Racine County and all of Wisconsin.

 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that the Racine County Clerk deliver a fully executed copy of this resolution to Governor Scott Walker and the entire Racine County delegation of state legislators.
