4. Review and discussion regarding status of seasonal operations and maintenance at the S. C. Johnson Community Aquatic Center at Pritchard Park

Dave Prott introduced Corporation Counsel Michael Lanzdorf, who provided an informational update concerning the S.C. Johnson Community Aquatic Center operations. Under the terms of the 2018 operations management agreement between Racine County and the Racine Family YMCA for the sports complex at Pritchard Park, the agreement may be extended for three additional summer terms (2019, 2020, and 2021) on the same terms, or mutually agreed upon revised terms, upon written approval of both parties. Lanzdorf summarized proposed terms of an amendment to the 2018 agreement, noting that the most significant proposed changes relate to more strictly defined auditing requirements and operating deficits/surpluses, all of which are favorable to the County.

No action by the Public Works, Parks and Facilities Committee is required at this time, as the inaugural agreement allowed for three renewal periods.
