WHEREAS, on August 27, 2019, Sentury Insurance filed a claim with Racine County on behalf of Fenway Corporation, the employer of Paul Hassler, in the amount of \$1,152.28 for medical expenses allegedly caused to Paul Hassler when he stepped into an uncovered drainage grate at the Racine County Dennis Kornwolf Service Center on March 15, 2018; and

WHEREAS, when Paul Hassler reported the incident on March 15, 2018, he indicated to Racine County Buildings and Facilities staff that he had previously noticed that the grate covering the drainage trough was missing; and

WHEREAS, the Corporation Counsel and the Racine County Buildings and Facilities Department have investigated this claim and recommend denial based on the investigation of the incident.
