6 **WHEREAS**, on July 1, 2019, Attorney Terry Constant filed a claim with Racine
7 County on behalf of Daniel Boudreau in the amount of \$50,000.00 for pain and suffering,
8 medical expenses, and disability caused to Mr. Boudreau by another inmate, Jeffrey
9 Greene, in the Racine County Jail on June 16, 2018 alleging that the injuries resulted from
10 Racine County Jail improperly classifying and housing Mr. Greene with Mr. Boudreau; and
11

12 **WHEREAS**, the Racine County Jail's Classification Officers review inmate's
13 previous and current charges, jail discipline history, assaultive history, jail intake behavior,
14 age, employment history, education and staff recommendations in determining
15 classification; and
16

17 **WHEREAS**, the Racine County Jail reviewed Mr. Boudreau's classification status
18 on May 27, 2018 and appropriately placed him in medical segregation. The Racine County
19 Jail reviewed Mr. Greene's classification on June 12, 2018 and appropriately placed him in
20 medical segregation; and

22 **WHEREAS**, an investigation was completed by the Racine County Sheriff's Office
23 regarding this incident on June 16, 2018 and subsequently Inmate Jeffrey S. Greene was
24 reclassified, placed in administrative segregation, and charged with the following:

- 25 a. 940.20 (1): Battery by prisoner
- 26 b. 947.01 (1): Disorderly Conduct; and

28 **WHEREAS**, the Corporation Counsel and the Racine County Sheriff's Office have
29 investigated this claim and recommend denial based on the investigation and the
30 untimeliness of the notice.
