The Racine County Board of Supervisors recognizes its responsibilities under 16 W.S.A., § 106.50, and endorses the concepts of fair and open housing for all persons 17 and prohibition of discrimination therein. 18 19 The Racine County Board of Supervisors hereby adopts W.S.A., § 106.50, 20 and all subsequent amendments thereto as a policy statement and it is the declared policy of this county that all persons shall have an equal opportunity 21 for housing regardless of sex, race, color, sexual orientation, disability, religion, 22 23 national origin, marital status, family status, status as a victim of domestic abuse, sexual assault, or stalking, lawful source of income, age or ancestry. 24 (2) The officials and employees of Racine County shall assist in the orderly 25 prevention and removal of all discrimination in housing within Racine County by 26 cooperating fully with all investigations and prosecutions by the Department of 27 Workforce Development in regard to violations of W.S.A., § 106.50. 28 The county clerk shall maintain forms for complaints to be filed under W.S.A., 29 § 106.50, and shall assist any person alleging a violation thereof in Racine 30 County to file a complaint thereunder with the Wisconsin Department of 31 Workforce Development, Equal Rights Division, for enforcement of W.S.A., § 32 106.50. 33 (Ord.
