6 **WHEREAS**, Road Quake 2 Folder (Rumble Strips) are designed to reduce accidents and
7 save lives by alerting distracted drivers to changing road conditions, like work zones; and
8

9 **WHEREAS**, the Road Quake 2 Folder (Rumble Strips) are designed to be deployed in an
10 array consisting of three (3) rumble strips spaced and placed transverse across the lane at work
11 zone locations; and
12

13 **WHEREAS**, Racine County shall purchase three (3) sets (six in each set) allowing two
14 complete sets to be at the Ives Grove & Rochester locations with one set already purchased and
15 currently being used; and
16

17 **WHEREAS**, the Road Quake 2 Folder (Rumble Strips) are kept in a “CRIB” (cargo carrier)
18 designed to transport, deploy, remove, storage and safe keeping of six (6) Road Quake 2 Folder
19 (Rumble Strips) purchasing four (4) units with mounting and retrieval systems; and

21 **WHEREAS**, the Public Works and Development Services Department intends to purchase
22 additional traffic safety equipment required by the State of Wisconsin to include: **18** signs w/stands
23 (Rumble Strips Ahead & End Road Work), **4** CP200D VHF Portable Radio’s, **4** DOT-Z1 distance
24 measuring instruments, **8** air horns w/clips; and

26 **WHEREAS**, itemized costs of other necessary traffic safety equipment are as follows:

37 **(Rumble Strips)”** will be required and implemented for all State projects starting January 1, 2020;

40 **WHEREAS**, Racine County shall adopt and use the new Wisconsin Flagging Handbook
41 procedures and use the new mandated traffic control equipment **“Road Quake 2 Folder (Rumble**
42 **Strips)”** on all County roadways starting January 1, 2020 as County policy and standards
43 incorporating into internal work and safety rules for the Public Works and Development Services
44 Department.
