6 **WHEREAS**, on October 30, 2019, Jessica Richter filed a claim with Racine County
7 for an unspecified amount for property damage allegedly caused to her vehicle during a
8 Public Works and Development Services road painting operation on October 24, 2019; and
9

10 **WHEREAS**, Ms. Richter claimed that one of the paint trucks sprayed the side of her
11 vehicle when the truck was pulled to the side and as she drove past; and
12

13 **WHEREAS**, the Public Works and Development Services Department investigated
14 the claim which included reviewing video footage from the painting trucks involved in the
15 painting operation; and
16

17 **WHEREAS**, video of the incident shows that Ms. Richter already had white paint
18 along the passenger side of her vehicle before she passed the painting trucks which
19 indicates that she drove over the wet paint before passing the paint trucks; and
20

21 **WHEREAS**, the Corporation Counsel and the Racine County Public Works and
22 Development Services Department have investigated this claim and recommend denial
23 based on the investigation of the incident.
