6 7 8 9	WHEREAS , on October 30, 2019, Jessica Richter filed a claim with Racine County for an unspecified amount for property damage allegedly caused to her vehicle during a Public Works and Development Services road painting operation on October 24, 2019; and
10 11 12	WHEREAS , Ms. Richter claimed that one of the paint trucks sprayed the side of her vehicle when the truck was pulled to the side and as she drove past; and
13 14 15	WHEREAS, the Public Works and Development Services Department investigated the claim which included reviewing video footage from the painting trucks involved in the painting operation; and
