DRUNK DRIVING

PREVALENT | DEADLY | EMBARRASSING | PREVENTABLE

In Wisconsin:

37% of drunk driving convictions are repeat offenders.

There were **23,931** convictions for drunk driving offenses last year.

Alcohol related crashes **killed 190 people**

& injured nearly **2,872** in 2015

33.7% of all fatal traffic crashes in 2015 were alcohol-related.

41.3% of all fatal motorcycle crashes were alcohol-related.



A Decision You'll Regret the Rest of Your Life

If you're arrested, you can **lose your license** & be fined.

Repeat drunken drivers **face imprisonment**.

If you **hurt or kill someone** in a crash, you could face serious charges like **negligent homicide** or **operating while intoxicated (OWI) causing injury**.



Entirely Preventable

Choose a **sober designated driver**.

If you're feeling buzzed, you're likely over the **0.08 limit** and should not drive.

Rather than risk arrest or a crash, take mass transit, a taxicab or ask a sober friend to drive you home.

Save a life – don't let your friends drive drunk!
