INFORMATION ONLY

WHEREAS, Racine County received \$1,436,737.61 from the FBI/Federal Government for capital improvements to the Robert L. Rohner Training Center in the Village of Caledonia back in 2004.

WHEREAS, part of the funds that were received were used to design and construct an upper concrete pad and a pneumatic turning target system for the firing range.

WHEREAS, the FBI/Federal Government has approved and allocated \$180,000 for the renovation and replacement of the upper concrete pad and the target system at the Robert L. Rohner Training Center but before commencing said replacement the FBI/Federal Government is requiring an amendment to the 2004 Cooperative Agreement between Racine County Sheriff's Office and the Federal Bureau of Investigation for Construction of a Joint Use Firearms Training Facility.

WHEREAS, the Racine County Corporation Counsel and Racine County Sheriff's Office will review and approve any agreements and any addenda prior to execution.
