6 **WHEREAS**, on January 7, 2020, Attorneys Ricky J. Mundt and Blayne Nicole
7 Steinkraus filed a claim with Racine County in the amount of \$8,942.50 on behalf of
8 American Standard Insurance Company of Wisconsin for property damage and personal
9 injury to its insureds Kenneth and Marcia Baldwin for damage allegedly caused to the
10 Baldwin's motorcycle and their subsequent medical bills after their motorcycle allegedly
11 slipped on loose gravel on North Britton Road near the intersection of Bennet Road on
12 September 8, 2019; and

14 **WHEREAS**, the American Standard claims that the loose gravel on the road
15 allegedly caused their insureds to crash causing property damage and personal injuries to
16 both parties; and

18 **WHEREAS**, the Corporation Counsel and the Racine County Department of Public
19 Works and Development Services have investigated this claim and recommend denial
20 based on the lack of jurisdiction of the area stated in the claim; the intersection and
21 surrounding area belong to the Town of Dover and the Town of Norway. Additionally,
22 Racine County was not responsible for any work done to the roadways in that area during
23 that time.
