RESOLUTION BY THE PUBLIC WORKS, PARKS AND FACILITIES COMMITTEE AUTHORIZING A PROJECT GRANT APPLICATION AND ACCEPTANCE OF FUNDING THROUGH THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES (DNR) MUNICIPAL DAM GRANT PROGRAM FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF THE WATERFORD DAM GATES

To the Honorable Members of the Racine County Board of Supervisors:

BE IT RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that the Racine County Public Works Department is hereby authorized to seek assistance and submit an application to the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) for a financial grant for a project in the estimated amount of \$350,000 for the design and construction of replacing two radial gates on the Waterford Dam;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that Racine County is authorized to perform the planning, engineering, specification preparation and budget analysis for the necessary repairs to the Waterford Dam;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Racine County hereby authorizes the Racine County Director of Public Works to:

- Submit an application to the DNR for financial aid under Wis. Admin. Code ch. NR 335;
- Sign grant agreement documents with necessary Racine County approvals;
- Take all necessary action to complete the project associated with any grant agreement; and
- Submit reimbursement claims along with necessary supporting documentation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that Racine County agrees to pay a share of the eligible costs which is equal to the total project cost minus the state share;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that Racine County, as a condition of any grant awarded, will comply with state and federal rules for the program;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that Corporation Counsel is authorized to prepare or review any agreement or other document, with the necessary and appropriate terms and conditions to facilitate this improvement;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that additional terms and conditions may be applicable as the Corporation Counsel and the Director of Public Works deem necessary and appropriate; and

5 6 7 8 9	WHEREAS, Racine County is the owner and operator of the Waterford Dam on the Fox River in the Village of Waterford and controls the dam in accordance with orders prescribed by the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (DNR); and
10 11 12	WHEREAS , the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) and Racine County's engineering consultant have inspected the Waterford Dam; and
13 14 15	WHEREAS, the DNR has ordered that the County replace the two radial gates on the Waterford Dam by December 1, 2016; and
16 17 18	WHEREAS, the DNR is currently accepting applications for grant funding to perform repairs on dams, with applications due by January 21, 2016; and
19 20 21 22	WHEREAS , Racine County owns the Waterford Dam and requests financial assistance under s. 31.385 and s. 227.11, Wis. Stats., and ch. NR 335, Wis. Admin. Code, for the purpose of the design and repair of the dam; and
23 24 25 26	WHEREAS , the state share for such a project may not exceed 50 percent (50%) of the first \$400,000 of total eligible project costs nor 25 percent (25%) of the next \$800,000 of total eligible costs; and
26 27 28 29	WHEREAS , the DNR municipal dam grant will fund 50% of the estimated \$350,000 total project cost for design and construction totaling \$175,000; and
30 31 32	WHEREAS, the project requires local match funds of 50% of the estimated \$350,000 total project costs for design and construction totaling \$175,000; and
33 34	WHEREAS , the local matching funds for this grant are authorized in the 2015 and 2016 budgets in the amount of \$350,000.
