| WHEREAS, while the detention staff did not receive an increase, these positions were converted from contracted staff to county staff in order to attract and retain employees for the Racine County Juvenile Detention center; and   |
| <b>WHEREAS</b> , while this was a good first step, the Human Services Department recognizes that in order to continue to provide high quality service for our youth in detention, the Department needs to ensure that staff are receiving continuous training, feedback and support; and                           |
| WHEREAS, in order to remedy this and ensure that the detained youth are receiving a high level of supervision and intervention, the Racine County Human Services Director requests the elimination of one Detention Worker position and the creation of one Lead Detention Worker position; and                    |
| <b>WHEREAS</b> , the position will provide an added layer of supervision, training, and support for detention staff as well as create a clear career ladder that will, in turn, attract and retain more staff as Racine County continues to prepare for the Secure Residential Care Center for Children and Youth. |
