18 **WHEREAS**, In 2015 the Village of Mt. Pleasant Police Department (MPPD) was
19 awarded a grant through the State of Wisconsin Department of Transportation for a multi-
20 jurisdictional speed and alcohol task force; and

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22 **WHEREAS**, The Racine County Sheriff's Office participated, along with other
23 Racine County law enforcement agencies and the Racine County Communication Center,
24 and conducted 19 deployments in 2015; and

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26 **WHEREAS**, the Racine County Sheriff's office has been informed that MPPD will be
27 administering the grant for the 2016 fiscal year; and

29 **WHEREAS**, as project coordinators, MPPD indicated that the Sheriff's Office share
30 of the 2016 grant funds will be \$13,000; and

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32 **WHEREAS**, there is a 25% local match requirement for the grant and the Sheriff's
33 Office intends to satisfy their local match by use of regular duty enforcement and
34 administrative time regarding the grant; and

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36 **WHEREAS**, the Sheriff's Office requests authorization for the County to seek the
37 grant award in accordance with established accounting procedures and that the revenues
38 be deposited in the appropriate account to replace the expenditures.
