## **RACINE COUNTY COVID-19 UPDATE**

### **April 9, 2020**

#### **Overview**

The Central Racine County Health Department jurisdiction is reporting the death of a female in her 90s from complications of coronavirus (COVID-19), the third coronavirus-related death in Racine County.

#### **Number of confirmed coronavirus cases**

United States: 427,460  
Wisconsin: 2,885  
Central Racine County Health Department: 52 (2 deaths)  
City of Racine Health Department: 46 (1 death)  
Racine County total: 98 (3 deaths)
