All you have to do is:

1. Complete the 2020 Census at [www.my2020Census.gov](http://www.my2020Census.gov) or Call 844-330-2020 (English), 844-468-2020 (Spanish), or complete the paper Census mailed to your house.

**Pandemic Unemployment Assistance (PUA) now available in Wisconsin**

The DWD is currently taking applications for PUA benefits. PUA is a new federal unemployment benefit created in the CARES Act. PUA is for individuals who are unemployed and otherwise not eligible for unemployment benefits. PUA is for up to 39 weeks and covers self-employed individuals, independent contractors, people with limited recent work history, and others not covered by regular UI.
