Who Qualifies

Your household may be eligible for Wisconsin Home Energy Assistance Program (WHEAP) if the gross income for your household is less than the amount shown on the following chart. In most cases the energy assistance benefit is paid directly to the household energy supplier.

To Apply

- You must complete a WHEAP application with the assistance of an Intake Worker
- Provide your most recent energy bill
- Photo ID (first time clients)
- Social Security Number and Date of Birth of everyone in your household
- Documentation of Lawful Immigration Status if you are not a US Citizen
- Landlord Information -- if applicable
- Proof of Income for your entire household's gross income for the last month (please bring as many of the below options as apply)
 - Check stubs
 - Self-Employment Income/Tax Documents
 - Social Security Payments
 - SSI and SSDI Payments
 - Child Support Payments
 - Pensions, Annuities or IRAs
 - TANF /W2 Benefits
