City of Racine, in partnership with Racine County, the State of Wisconsin, and Wisconsin National Guard will be holding a drive-thru COVID-19 community testing site in the City of Racine at Festival Hall. **The site will be open Monday, May 18th, through Friday, May 22nd from 9:00 am to 6:00 pm daily.**

"Given the spike in cases the City has seen and the disproportionate impact it has had on communities of color, we made a request of the National Guard to set up a community testing site. All members of the community are able to get tested at this site, but I want to specifically encourage members of the City's minority communities and essential workers to get tested. We will have interpreters on site to assist our Spanish-speaking residents," said Mayor Cory Mason.

Updates Relative to COVID-19 for Communities:

City of Racine - A local "Safer at Home - Racine" order was issued the evening of May 13, 2020, by the City of Racine's Public Health Administrator, following the Wisconsin Supreme Court ruling. This adopts Wisconsin's Safer at Home order for the City of Racine and Villages of Wind Point and Elmwood Park until 8:00 am on Tuesday, May 26, 2020. In addition, the City of Racine is in the process of finalizing guidance which is aligned with the Badger Bounce Back plan and will allow for a safe, gradual reopening of the community.

Central Racine County Health Dept. - The Central Racine County Health Department has issued new, strong recommendations in the department's jurisdiction. These include recommendations on limiting the number of customers and staff in one location, limiting mass gatherings, and cancelling or postponing fairs and festivals. 
