## **RACINE COUNTY COVID-19 UPDATE May 21, 2020**

### **Confirmed coronavirus cases**

United States: 1,562,714

Wisconsin: 13,885

Central Racine County Health Department: 426 confirmed, 109 probable, 3,650 negative, 12 deaths

City of Racine Health Department: 781 confirmed, 96 probable, 2,827 negative, 8 deaths

Racine County total: 1,207 confirmed, 205 probable, 6,477 negative, 20 deaths

Positive test percentage: 15.7%

The community-based clinic at Festival Hall in the City of Racine continues through Friday. Hours are 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. Bilingual staff will be on hand to help with translation. Through Wednesday, 1,559 tests have been administered.
