INFORMATION ONLY

WHEREAS, on July 18, 2019, Anne Stark failed to stop at a stop sign at the intersection of HWY 11 (Durand Avenue) and HWY J (S. English Settlement Avenue) and caused a motor vehicle accident resulting in injuries to herself and the death and serious injuries to two individuals riding in another vehicle; and

WHEREAS, on February 27, 2020, by way of her Attorney Robert J. Dvorak, Anne Stark filed a claim against the Racine County Traffic Safety Commission (and the Wisconsin DOT) alleging negligence on behalf of the County and the State claiming the intersection was known to be unsafe but that the named parties failed to take proper precautions to improve the safety of the intersection; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works and Development Services Department and the Office of the Corporation Counsel investigated the claim and found that the intersection of HWY 11 (Durand Avenue) and HWY J (S. English Settlement Avenue) is under the sole jurisdiction of the Wisconsin DOT; and

WHEREAS, Racine County has taken voluntary and proactive actions to improve the intersection; and

WHEREAS, witness statements reported to the Racine County Sheriff's Office, which investigated the accident, indicate that Anne Stark was seen driving recklessly just before the incident; and

WHEREAS, Anne Stark was cited and found in default for Failure to Stop at a Stop Sign and Failure to Stop at a Stop Sign Resulting in Death; and

WHEREAS, the deadline for Anne Stark to file a Notice of Claim was November 15, 2020 but her claim was not filed until February 27, 2020, therefore the filing is not timely; and

WHEREAS, Anne Stark's actions resulted in her injuries and the death and injuries of the other parties; and

WHEREAS, the Racine County Corporation Counsel Office and Public Works and Development Services Department have reviewed this matter, and both recommend denial of this claim.
