### **Confirmed coronavirus cases**

United States: 2,036,429

Wisconsin: 22,246

Central Racine County Health Department: 606 confirmed, 133 probable, 9,311 negative, 32 deaths

City of Racine Health Department: 1,379 confirmed, 183 probable, 8,401 negative, 21 deaths

Racine County total: 1,985 confirmed, 316 probable, 17,712 negative, 53 deaths

Positive test percentage, total: 10%

Positive test percentage, 14-day rolling average: 5%
