## **Confirmed coronavirus cases**

United States: 2,150,923 Wisconsin: 23.454

Central Racine County Health Department: 635 confirmed, 143 probable, 10,540 negative, 34

deaths

City of Racine Health Department: 1,411 confirmed, 185 probable, 8,987 negative, 22 deaths

Racine County total: 2,046 confirmed, 328 probable, 19,527 negative, 56 deaths

Positive test percentage: 9.5%

## **Central Racine County and City of Racine Health Department**

Consensus from the research community, along with a corrected statement from the World Health Organization, indicate the possibility remains that COVID-19 may be transmitted from frequently-touched surfaces. This weekend is the official start of summer. As you venture out, please consider the gas pump as one such surface. When you get gas:

- Use disinfecting wipes on handles and buttons before you touch them (if available).
- After fueling, use a hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol.
- Wash your hands for at least 20 seconds with soap and water when you get home or to your destination.
