RESOLUTION BY THE FINANCE AND HUMAN RESOURCES COMMITTEE AUTHORIZING CHANGES TO THE HUMAN SERVICES STAFF WAGE SCHEDULE EFFECTIVE AUGUST 1, 2020 AND AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF \$77,517.00 WITHIN THE HUMAN SERVICES DEPARTMENT 2020 BUDGET

To the Honorable Members of the Racine County Board of Supervisors:

WHEREAS, the starting wage for a Juvenile Detention Worker in Racine County is currently \$15.71 which is the lowest rate in the state and is lower than the starting rate for Racine County Jail Correctional Officers; and

WHEREAS, the turnover rate for Juvenile Detention Workers is high due to the wage scale and many workers leave the position and transfer to the Racine County Jail or to other counties with higher wages; and

WHEREAS, the cost to train one Juvenile Detention Worker is \$10,887.76; and

WHEREAS, to reduce the turnover rate, the Racine County Human Services Director proposes and increase in the staff wage schedule to ensure that staff are receiving and equitable rate of pay and to provide consistent, high quality care to youth in the Juvenile Detention Facility.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that the transfer of funds, as set forth in Exhibit "A" that is attached hereto, within the Human Services Department 2020 Budget is hereby authorized and approved.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that the changes to the staff wage schedule, as set forth in Exhibit "B" that is attached hereto, within the Human Services Department 2020 Budget effective August 1, 2020 is hereby authorized and approved.

WHEREAS, as Racine County prepares for the Secure Residential Care Center for Children & Youth (SRCCCY), it is important to continue to provide high quality service for the youth in detention and ensure that staff are receiving an equitable rate of pay to provide a high level of trauma informed care to the youth in the facility.
