A decision is expected at the next court date which is July 20, 2020. Committee has potentially identified suitable housing; matter is being reviewed and HSD will send a report to DHS before the end of the week.

James Hinkle & Daniel Williams: Continued motion hearing regarding Hinkle's and William's motion to compel scheduled on April 24, 2020 was rescheduled to June 30, 2020 due to the COVID-19 pandemic. The Office of Corporation Counsel intends to call two Committee members to testify (Kim Christman and Michelle Goggins) to support the County's arguments against their motions to compel. Committee has potentially identified suitable housing for Hinkle, matter is being reviewed; HSD will send a report to DHS before the end of the week.

Preston Rintamaki: At the June 2, 2020 hearing, the Court dismissed his chapter 980 commitment; he has been discharged and moved back to Racine County.

Hung Tran: Order for Supervised Release was entered on February 14, 2020. The Racine County Office of the Corporation Counsel filed a Chapter 980 Report on June 12, 2020.
