- a. Register of Deeds Connie Cobb Madsen gave an update of the Register of Deeds office. She stated she is in process of hiring the Deputy Register of Deeds. Register of Deeds Cobb Madsen explained her budget, expenses and revenue from fees. The Register of Deeds office records deeds, the Land Information office verifies the information is correct. Website and Land Shark are very helpful tools for public information. Changes to vital records include the ability to get your birth and marriage certificates from any Wisconsin county, excluding certain years. Real ID goes into effect in October 2020, and Real ID requires certified copies of vital records. Questions and discussion ensued.
- b. Pam Larsen gave 2021 Youth In Governance nominations update. Pam has received 64 nominations and 21 applications so far. Interviews will be on February 26 and March 3 if needed. Nine schools are represented. Pam explained score sheets and criteria for interviews. Questions and discussion ensued. Pam also gave update on current Youth in Governance projects. Mention was made to ask the County Board Chairman for dedicated funds for the Youth in Governance projects.
