1 2 **RESOLUTION NO. 2020-43** 3 4 RESOLUTION BY INDIVIDUAL SUPERVISORS TO CONDUCT COUNTYWIDE 5 ADVISORY REFERENDUM ON CREATION OF NONPARTISAN PROCEDURE FOR 6 THE PREPARATION OF LEGISLATIVE AND CONGRESSIONAL REDISTRICTING 7 PLANS AND MAPS 8 9 To the Honorable Members of the Racine County Board of Supervisors: 10 11 WHEREAS, the Racine County Board of Supervisors on August 28, 2018, 12 passed Resolution No. 2018-46 calling for nonpartisan legislative and congressional 13 redistricting maps; and 14 WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IV, Section 3 of the Wisconsin Constitution, the 15 Wisconsin Legislature is directed to redistrict state legislative districts "according to the 16 number of inhabitants" at its next session following the decennial federal census. The 17 legislature also reapportions congressional districts at the same interval pursuant to 18 federal law; and 19 WHEREAS, there are numerous indicators that the citizens of Wisconsin are 20 concerned about the practice of redistricting by whichever party holds the majority, 21 because it may stifle political participation and competition, discourage collaboration 22 and compromise, and lack the fairness necessary to our democratic process, by 23 undermining the principle of one-person-one vote; and 24 WHEREAS, the current procedure allows the legislature of the majority party to 25 prepare redistricting plans and maps that may result in unfair partisan plans and maps, 26 allowing the legislature to choose its voters rather than the voters choosing their 27 representatives, which is commonly called gerrymandering. 28 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Racine County Board of 29 Supervisors, in legal session assembled, does hereby approve that the following 30 question be placed on the November 3, 2020 ballot as an advisory referendum 31 question: 32 Question: Should the Wisconsin legislature create a nonpartisan procedure for 33 the preparation of legislative and congressional district plans and maps? 34 YES NO 35 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Corporation Counsel prepare a Notice of 36 Referendum to be published by the Racine County Clerk in accordance with statutory 37 requirements; and 38 BE IT STILL FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution and the referendum 39 shall be filed with the Racine County Clerk no later than 70 days prior to the election at

which the question will appear on the ballot; and
