## RACINE COUNTY COVID-19 UPDATE August 24, 2020

## Confirmed coronavirus cases

United States: 5,728,363 confirmed, 177,036 deaths

Wisconsin: 70,854 confirmed, 1,119,622 negative, 1,081 deaths

Central Racine County Health Department: 1,703 confirmed (+83 from last week), 197 probable

(+11), 28,268 negative (+1,274), 53 deaths (+2)

City of Racine Health Department: 2,128 confirmed (+44 from last week), 234 probable (+3),

21,972 negative (+1,423), 32 deaths (+1)

Racine County total: 3,831 confirmed (+127 from last week), 431 probable (+14), 50,240

negative (+2,697), 85 deaths (+3) Positive test percentage: 7%

## **Updates for the week of August 24:**

- After a surge of cases in July, Racine County's case rate has fallen this month, though
  the county remains in the "high risk" category and testing has declined due to national
  testing supply shortages. It's imperative that residents continue to wear face coverings
  outside their homes, maintain social distancing, not hold or attend large gatherings, stay
  home if sick, and practice good hygiene.
- Racine County will distribute COVID-19 care packages from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m.
  Wednesday, Aug. 26, at the Racine County Service Center in Burlington, 1072
  Milwaukee Ave. Residents in need are invited to pick up a free care package filled with food, facemasks, and other essential items to help during the COVID-19 pandemic. For more information, click here.
