

Official Proclamation

By the County Executive
Of Racine County, Wisconsin

Whereas: Title VIII of the 1968 Civil Rights Act, commonly known as the Fair Housing Act, guarantees fair housing opportunities for all Americans; and

WHEREAS, the Fair Housing Act prohibits discrimination in housing due to race, color, religion, gender, national origin, familial status or disability; and

WHEREAS, the provision of fair housing opportunities for residents of Racine County is crucial to the health and well-being of residents and our communities; and

WHEREAS, the Racine County Board of Supervisors endorsed the concepts of fair and open housing and prohibited discrimination through an ordinance passed in 2002; and

WHEREAS, by supporting and promoting fair housing and equal opportunity, Racine County is creating more vibrant communities and we encourage others to abide by the letter and the spirit of the Fair Housing Act;


NOW THEREFORE, I, Jonathan Delagrave, County Executive of Racine County, hereby proclaim the week of September 20-27, 2020, as
