

On September 30th, I met on-site with the applicant, Elizabeth Walker, at 35111 Hill Valley Drive in the Town of Waterford to discuss manure management.

We discussed management based on a maximum number of 50 horses. Elizabeth stated they will build a concrete slab manure storage with concrete blocks on three sides. The manure will be stacked there until it is getting full, then it will either bed spread on the cropland or hauled away in the dumpster. The storage slab will be located east of the barn as shown on the site plan. The proposed storage slab is not located in an area of environmental concern.

The manure will be spread on the fields on this property in the spring and fall or hauled away by dumpster. The manure will not be spread or stacked with 50 feet of the water well. When manure is spread, it should be spread at a thickness of less than 3 inches. Manure will not be spread within 30 feet of the wetland or flood plain at the south end of the property.

The applicant will submit a certified nutrient management plan to the Land Conservation office by June 1, 2021.
