## COVID Related Updates

The following is an excerpt from a recent news release by the Central Racine County Health Department:

*“Between the first and last week of September, the CRCHD jurisdiction saw a 275% increase in the number of reported cases. The jurisdiction is seeing more cases than any time during the pandemic. These increases have occurred across all age groups and are impacting all areas of the county. Meanwhile, CDC data shows that Wisconsin is currently third in the country in cases over the last seven days. Last, according to*

*Wisconsin Department of Health Services, southeast Wisconsin hospitals are at or over 90% ICU capacity, and the total number of hospitalized COVID patients is at the highest number since May.”*

## COVID-19 Test Results

**Have you been waiting more than 5 days for your COVID-19 test results?  
Do you need a copy of your test results?**

**The Wisconsin Department of Health Service has launched a  
COVID-19 Test Result Hotline for individuals tested at  
ANY Wisconsin National Guard testing site.**

**Get your results by calling the Wisconsin COVID-19 Results Line  
at (866) 419-6988.**

The COVID-19 Results Line is open Monday-Friday from 8 AM – 6 PM.

When you call, you will need to provide:

- The date of your test,
- The National Guard testing site you visited,
- Your name, and
- Your date of birth.

In addition to getting your results over the phone, the Results Line can mail your test results to you.

Please wait to call the Results Line until 5 days after your test. If you call before the 5-day mark, they cannot guarantee your results will be ready.
