

Racine County Board Supervisor – District 10

Applications are being accepted to fill the unexpired term of County Board Supervisor Emily Lawrence, District 10, which expires on April 18, 2022. Applicants must be at least 18 years old, a U.S. citizen, a resident of District 10 (located in that portion of the Village of Caledonia contained in the 8th, 9th, 10th, and 11th municipal wards, the entire Village of North Bay, and the entire Village of Wind Point, and that portion of the City of Racine contained in the 36th municipal ward), and eligible to hold elective and appointed public office under Article XIII, sec. 3(2) of the Wisconsin Constitution (“No person convicted of a felony, in any court within the United States, no person convicted in federal court of a crime designated, at the time of commission, under federal law as a misdemeanor involving a violation of public trust and no person convicted, in a court of a state, of a crime designated, at the time of commission, under the law of the state as a misdemeanor involving a violation of public trust shall be eligible to any office of trust, profit or honor in this state unless pardoned of the conviction.”). Individuals interested in applying for the vacancy should submit a letter of interest, a resume, and a completed notarized affidavit to the Racine County Clerk’s Office, 730 Wisconsin Avenue, Racine, WI 53403 by 5 p.m. on Monday, November 30, 2020. Blank affidavits are available from the County Clerk’s Office. Applicant interviews may be conducted at the Racine County Courthouse or virtually on a date to be determined.
