RESOLUTION BY THE PUBLIC WORKS, PARKS AND FACILITIES COMMITTEE AUTHORIZING A COST-SHARING AGREEMENT BETWEEN RACINE COUNTY AND THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF THE ARMY FOR THE HORLICK DAM FISH PASSAGE AND HABITAT RESTORATION SECTION 506 GREAT LAKES FISHERY AND ECOSYSTEM RESTORATION STUDY AND AN INITIAL PAYMENT OF \$30,000 TO THE US ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS

To the Honorable members of the Racine County Board of Supervisors:

BE IT RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that the Racine County Public Works Department is hereby authorized to enter into a cost-share agreement with the US Army Corps of Engineers for assistance in conducting a feasibility study attendant to bringing the Horlick Dam into compliance with an order from the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (WI-DNR);

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that Racine County is authorized to cost share \$30,000 towards the feasibility study, as set forth in Exhibit "A" that is attached hereto, which will include costs for preparing the project management plan, for plan formulation and evaluation, including costs for economic, engineering, real estate, and environmental analyses, for preparation of a floodplain management plan, for preparing a decision document, for supervision and administration, and for other various costs for the study incurred by the government, before or after entering into the agreement;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that the Horlick Dam must be brought into compliance with the WI-DNR order by April 2024, and that various alternatives are being studied up to and including possible removal of the Horlick Dam and; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that this feasibility study by the US Army Corps of Engineers will assist Racine County in making a final decision to bring the Horlick Dam into compliance by April 2024.

WHEREAS, Racine County is the owner and operator of the Horlick Dam on the Root River in the City of Racine; and

 WHEREAS, the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources issued an order to Racine County in 2014 indicating that the Horlick Dam is out of compliance with dam safety regulations; and

WHEREAS, the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources has set a deadline of April 2024 for Racine County to bring the Horlick Dam into compliance with dam safety regulations; and

WHEREAS, the United States Army Corps of Engineers has indicated an interest in assisting Racine County with this effort by helping fund and complete a feasibility study because the Root River empties into Lake Michigan which is a water of the United States; and

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WHEREAS, this cost-sharing agreement will enable Racine County to save money on conducting the feasibility study on its own, and it may bring grant money opportunities to bring the Horlick Dam into compliance at a reduced cost to Racine County taxpayers; and

WHEREAS, Racine County is asked to share \$30,000 to get the study started, with a total expense to the County to not exceed \$105,000 and the total cost of the study projected to be \$210,000; and

WHEREAS, the feasibility study is set to begin in late 2020, upon approval of this Resolution and execution of the Agreement.
