## RACINE COUNTY COVID-19 UPDATE November 23, 2020

### Confirmed coronavirus cases

United States: 12,349,443 confirmed, 257,274 deaths

Wisconsin: 357,771 confirmed, 2,094,448 negative, 3,011 deaths

Central Racine County Health Department: 6,803 confirmed (+789 from last week), 765 probable (+80), 52,491 negative (+2,249), 104 deaths (+9)

City of Racine Health Department: 5,626 confirmed (+488 from last week), 577 probable (+44), 37,738 negative (+1,792), 48 deaths (+4)

Racine County total: 12,429 confirmed (+1,277 from last week), 1,342 probable (+124), 90,229 negative (+4,041), 152 deaths (+13)

Positive test percentage: 12.1%
