

New CDC Guidelines have options for the 14-day quarantine for close contacts to a COVID case to be shortened to 7-10 days. As long as individuals have not had any symptoms, they can end quarantine after 7 days and an approved negative test result, or after 10 days without a test. However, the CDC "gold standard" for quarantine remains 14 days, because the incubation period for COVID-19 is 2-14 days. To see the updated "Quick Guide" click here.
