Supervisor Hincz asked about insurance coverage, and Madson indicated that there is insurance along with waivers signed by all participants prior to their participation in the event. A condition of approval will be for the cycling club to provide a Certificate of Insurance that names Racine County as an additional named insured for this particular event.

Supervisor Molnar indicated that South Shore emergency personnel need to be informed about this event at least 30 days prior to the race date. Molnar also provided an Incident Command System form (ICS 208) to staff to be completed by the race coordinators for submittal. This is a standard form and it allows all safety details to be clearly set forth prior to the event. Staff will incorporate this into the approval letter, if the Committee votes in favor of the proposed event.

Anderson indicated that this event is a week in advance of the Memorial Day holiday weekend, and that staff will work with the race coordinators on details that are outlined in their event request letter. Staff has no objection to the proposed event as stated in the submitted request. Ms. Madson was informed that, if approved, staff would create a letter of approval outlining the decision of the Committee.

Ms. Madson indicated that the cycling group has great interest in bringing this event to Racine County and that Sanders Park has a great set up for this road event.
