RESOLUTION BY THE PUBLIC WORKS, PARKS AND FACILITIES COMMITTEE TO APPROVE THE DESIGN FOR RESTORATION OF THE NORTHEAST POND LOCATED AT RACINE COUNTY PRITCHARD PARK AND TO AUTHORIZE ROOT-PIKE WIN TO SEEK GRANTS TO COVER COST OF SAID POND RESTORATION

To the Honorable members of the Racine County Board of Supervisors:

The Board approves the design for restoration of the northeast pond in Pritchard Park and authorizes Root-Pike WIN to seek grants to cover cost of said pond restoration as follows:

BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

- 1. The existing pond, located near the intersection of 21st Street and Ohio Street in the City of Racine has significant algae and e.Coli issues due to year-round geese population; and
- 2. Root-Pike WIN has researched best methods to restore the pond and to reduce the algae and e.Coli issues by way of a pond restoration project; and
- 3. This pond is an urban fishing pond, but it is in poor quality; and
- 4. Root Pike WIN is pursuing various grant opportunities to restore and naturalize the pond at Pritchard Park, at no cost to Racine County; and
- 5. Such other terms and conditions as the Corporation Counsel and Public Works and Development Services Director deem necessary and appropriate.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that any two of the County Clerk, the County Executive and/or the County Board Chairman are authorized to execute any contracts, agreements, amendments, or other documents necessary to carry out the intent of this resolution.
