REAUTHORIZING SELF-INSURANCE FOR RACINE COUNTY'S WORKER'S

To the Honorable Members of the Racine County Board of Supervisors:

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that it approves and authorizes the continuation of Racine County's self-insured worker's compensation program in compliance with Wisconsin Worker's Compensation Act and the Wisconsin Administrative Code and, in particular, section DWD 80.60(3); and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that Racine County agrees to report faithfully all compensable injuries; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that Racine County shall provide for the continuation of the current self-insured worker's compensation program that is currently in effect for all Racine County employees; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that the County Clerk is directed to forward a certified copy of this resolution to the Worker's Compensation Division, Wisconsin Department of Workforce Development.

19 **WHEREAS**, Racine County, Wisconsin is a qualified political subdivision of the  
20 State of Wisconsin; and

21  
22 **WHEREAS**, the Wisconsin Worker’s Compensation Act provides that employers  
23 covered by the Act either insure their liability with worker’s compensation insurance  
24 carriers authorized to do business in Wisconsin or to be exempted (self-insured) from  
25 insuring liabilities with a carrier and thereby assuming the responsibility for its own  
26 worker’s compensation risk and payment; and

28 **WHEREAS**, the state and its political subdivisions may self-insure worker’s  
29 compensation without a special order from the Department of Workforce Development if  
30 the self-insured entity agrees to report faithfully all compensable injuries and agrees to  
31 comply with the Act with the Wisconsin Worker’s Compensation Act and the rules of the  
32 Department.
