RESOLUTION BY THE FINANCE AND HUMAN RESOURCES COMMITTEE AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF A STATE OF WISCONSIN DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE - LAW ENFORCEMENT DRUG TRAFFICKING RESPONSE 2021 GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$49,200.00 FOR THE SOUTH EAST AREA DRUG OPERATIONS GROUP (SEADOG), AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF FUNDS WITHIN THE SHERIFF'S OFFICE - METRO DRUG STATE 2020 BUDGET, AND AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF CAPITAL – POLE CAMERA AND RELATED ITEMS

To the Honorable Members of the Racine County Board of Supervisors:

WHEREAS, the Wisconsin Department of Justice Division of Law Enforcement Services has approved a grant award to the Racine County Sheriff's Drug Unit in the amount of \$49,200.00; and

WHEREAS, grant funding is provided by the State of Wisconsin to support the investigation and response to drug trafficking within the state; and

WHEREAS, the Racine County Metro Drug Unit is part of a South East Area Drug Operations Group (SEADOG), a taskforce engaged in the ongoing investigation of drug trafficking operations in the Southeastern Wisconsin region and beyond; and

WHEREAS, the Racine County Sheriff's Office requests the acceptance of the DOJ grant monies to ensure continued success of the SEADOG mission.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that the Sheriff's Office is authorized to accept a Wisconsin Department of Justice Grant in the amount of \$49,200.00 to support the investigation and response to drug trafficking for the period of August 1, 2020 to June 30, 2021; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that the transfer of funds and capital purchase of a pole camera and related items, as set forth in Exhibit "A" that is attached hereto, within the Sheriff's Office Metro Drug 2020 budget is hereby authorized and approved.
