RESOLUTION BY THE PUBLIC WORKS, PARKS AND FACILITIES COMMITTEE ACCEPTING A GRANT FOR THE CLIFFSIDE PARK COASTAL WETLAND RESTORATION PROJECT IN COOPERATION WITH ROOT-PIKE WATERSHED INITIATIVE NETWORK.

To the Honorable members of the Racine County Board of Supervisors:

**WHEREAS** Cliffside Park is a designated "special coastal area" according to the SEWRPC and the Wisconsin Coastal Management Program.

**WHEREAS** this project is listed as "Highly Critical" in the EPA/DNR-approved Wind Point Watershed Restoration Plan.

**WHEREAS** the wetland/prairie area is threatened by invasive species and lack of vegetative diversity.

**WHEREAS** the Natural Heritage Inventory indicated endangered resources are present within the site.

**WHEREAS** such other terms and conditions as the Corporation Counsel and Public Works and Development Services Director deem necessary and appropriate.

**WHEREAS** Root-Pike Watershed Initiative Network ("Root-Pike WIN") has helped to secure a grant from the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service for wetland and upland work at Cliffside Park in the amount of \$137.240. (see Exhibit A).

**WHEREAS**, full funding and management of the project will be completely administered and supervised by the Root-Pike WIN, and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Racine County Public Works and Development Services Department will cooperatively work with the Root-Pike WIN to advance the design, implementation, and maintenance of this wetland restoration by:

1. Accepting the grants to enhance 24 acres of mapped potentially restorable wetlands and 9 Wisconsin Wetland Inventory acres.

2. Assisting the Root-Pike WIN and partnering agencies, as needed, to move the project forward this year.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Racine County Board of Supervisors that any two of the County Clerk, the County Executive and/or the County Board Chairman are authorized to execute any contracts, agreements, amendments, or other documents necessary to carry out the intent of this resolution.
