4. Presentation, discussion, and possible recommendation regarding driveway access to CTH G from 4403 Main St., Village of Wind Point

Anderson and Prott presented the item. Safety issue caused a denial of the permit. 2017 records show 4,300 vehicles per day at this location. County ordinance requires access to an alternate road if available when the County road is on the frontage. Applicant Wolf Korndoerfer indicated that there was not enough room for a shared driveway, however, the driveway would be moved further South to 100' from the Deep Woods Drive.

Discussion followed.

Staff supports one residential driveway onto CTH "G" as long as it is 100' from the intersection.

Supervisor Jody SPENCER moved, seconded by **Supervisor Kramer**, to approve the driveway to CTH "G" with a setback of at least 100' from the north edge of pavement center line to center line.
