1. Convene meeting

The meeting of the Ch. 980 Committee was called to order at 9:04 a.m. by Principal Assistant Corporation Counsel John Serketich.

2. Public Comments

There were members of the public present (Caledonia Police Department), but there were no comments.

3. Approve Agenda & Minutes

Agenda for June 28, 2021 meeting and Minutes from May 24, 2021 meeting reviewed.

4. <u>Legal updates (Office of Corporation Counsel)</u>

Legal Updates: 9:05 a.m.

Daniel Williams & Hung Tran:

Final order was entered on May 25, 2021 vacating prior order that had approved the residential property at 9901 Saratoga Drive for Mr. Williams and Mr. Tran. Per the May 25, 2021 order, the Committee has 120 days, or until September 22, 2021, to find a new residential option. Committee continues to search for suitable housing.

Dennis Yarber:

Order approving his supervised release was entered on April 21, 2021, which makes the 120-day deadline to identify a residential option August 19, 2021. Mr. Yarber is a serious child sex offender; therefore, he is subject to the additional statutory restrictions like Mr. Tran. Committee continues to search for suitable housing.

Jamerrel Everett:

Mr. Everett was committed under Chapter 980 in Waukesha County, Waukesha County Case Number 04-CI-01. DHS, however, identified Mr. Everett's county of residence for purposes of supervised release as Racine County. The Committee is reviewing information about Mr. Everett relating to that finding. Although the Committee is reviewing that information and has not yet received any orders from Waukesha County indicating that Racine County is the county of residence and required to identify a residential option, the Committee nevertheless has begun to search for an appropriate residential option. Angela Serwa indicated that likely no such order and/or change of venue would be received from Waukesha; rather, the notification from DHS/her via email would likely be the only notice. Assistant Corporation Counsel Erika Motsch to continue to research this case.

Ms. Goggins provided the update on HSD's evaluations performed on the potential properties sent by Ms. Christman, set forth below, as well as HSD's other efforts to identify appropriate properties for the pending committed persons.

May: 1,370 properties were referred to HSD for evaluation, of which only 376 had not been previously evaluated by HSD for conformity with statutory criteria. Of those 376 properties, 59 met statutory criteria after HSD's preliminary evaluation using the digital mapping tool. All 59 properties were sent to the vendors for consideration. One of the 59 properties exceeded the price point.
