Boot Camp Training Programs Accepting Applications

Racine County Workforce Solutions and Gateway Technical College Partner in CNC Machine Operator and Telecommunications Cable Installer training

Racine – Since 2005 Gateway Technical College and Racine County Workforce Solutions have partnered to offer intensive short-term training programs that equip local residents with the skills and credentials to secure in-demand jobs as Computer Numerical Control Machine Operators and Telecommunications Cable Installers.

The no-cost boot camps consist of 12 to 14 weeks of hands-on training offered 5 days per week at Gateway's cutting edge, iMET facility. Graduates receive a Certificate of Completion, college credits, job placement assistance and preparation for careers in manufacturing or telecommunications with wages ranging from an entry level rate of \$12.00 per hour to an experienced rate of \$20.00 per hour or more.
