ORDINANCE BY THE RACINE COUNTY PUBLIC WORKS, PARKS AND FACILITIES COMMITTEE AMENDING SECTION 12-72(5) OF THE RACINE COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES RELATING TO NO PARKING ZONES

To the Honorable Members of the Racine County Board of Supervisors:

The Racine County Board of Supervisors do ordain as follows:

Section 12-72(5) of the Racine County Code of Ordinances relating to no parking zones on County Highway "Y" (Meachem Road) is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 12-72. No parking zones enumerated.


- (5) County Trunk Highway "Y" (Meachem Road).
 - a. No parking at any time on the easterly side of CTH-"Y" from the centerline of STH-11 southerly for a distance of three hundred twenty (320) feet.
 - b. No parking at any time on the westerly side of CTH-"Y" from the centerline of STH-11 southerly for a distance of three hundred twenty (170) feet.
 - c. No parking at any time on the easterly side of CTH-"Y" from the centerline of Chicory Road southerly for a distance of four hundred thirteen (413) feet and northerly for a distance of two hundred eight (208) feet.
 - d. No parking at any time on the westerly side of CTH-"Y" from the centerline of West Knollwood Drive southerly for a distance of one hundred ninety seven (197) feet and northerly for a distance of four hundred seven (407) feet.





View from the East leg of Chicory Road intersection observed by the County. This viewpoint corresponds with the Drivers line-of-sight from a vehicle stopped on Chicory Road. Forward movement would bring stopped vehicle into conflict with CTH-Y traffic. Yet, parked-vehicles hide CTH-Y traffic from view. Photographed from the highway approximately 12.5 feet East CTH-Y. Camera facing Southward.



1/7/2022

View from the East leg of Chicory Road intersection observed by the County. This viewpoint corresponds with the Drivers line-of-sight from a vehicle already turning into CTH-Y traffic. Note approaching vehicle previously hidden from view at stop sign. Photographed from the highway approximately 5 feet East CTH-Y. Camera facing South.

The oncoming vehicle stands approximately 200 LF from the turning vehicle. Computations based on WisDOT standards indicate that the oncoming vehicle cannot stop in time to avoid a collision at the posted 40 m.p.h. speed.
